School Uniform

All pupils **should wear** the following:

- a white buttoned up collared shirt/blouse
- a school tie that is clearly visible at all times and **pushed to the top**
- a plain black jumper or cardigan that allows the tie to be seen
- black trousers or skirt and smart footwear (dark training shoes are acceptable)

Types of clothing which will **not be allowed** include clothes which:

- are a health and safety risk, e.g. track suits tops and bottoms, certain types of jewellery
- are offensive or indecent, e.g. clothes that are short, revealing or tight
- may offend or provoke others, promotes alcohol, drugs or tobacco
- shirts/blouses that are not plain white or cannot be buttoned up
- cardigans/jumpers that are not plain black
- denim clothing of any (including black), black leggings or shorts
- footwear that cause damage to the school fabric
- wellington boots and similar type footwear are only appropriate during inclement weather

Pupils not in uniform

- Any pupil not in school uniform should report to their Head of House **before** 8.50 am who will issue them with a **purple slip**. They will also be issued with a **10 minute Afterschool Detention** unless we have received an explanatory note or telephone call from parents.
- Period 1 teachers may also send pupils to their Head of House for a purple slip.
- After Period 1 any pupil not in uniform and without a purple slip should be issued with a punishment exercise (New standard school exercise) by their **class teachers**.

- If a pupil already has a punishment exercise for not wearing school uniform issued by the class teacher of a previous lesson do not issue a further punishment exercise.
- Staff should follow normal school discipline procedures if a pupil fails to return their punishment exercise.
